

Ann Marie DeAngelo

Director/Choreographer/Producer

Former Joffrey Ballet ballerina Ann Marie DeAngelo, was described by Anna Kisselgoff in the New York Times as "One of American ballet's most spectacular dancers...", and featured in TIMEMagazine as "One of Americas most outstanding ballerinas..." She has toured internationally as a guest artist, and worked with The Frankfurt Ballet under William Forsythe.

- DeAngelo was founding Artistic Director of Ballet de Monterrey, the first privately funded arts organization in Mexico;
- Artistic Director of her own experimental troupe, Ballet D'Angelo, which toured extensively in Europe,
- Associate Director of The Joffrey Ballet.
- As a choreographer DeAngelo works cross-genre and has created over 60 works including two musicals in China.
 Her one-act ghost love-story "The Bell Witch" was nominated for a Benois de la Danse Award, and a segment of it was performed at The Bolshoi Theater, Moscow.
- DeAngelo has directed and produced over 20 multi-genre dance extravaganzas working with thousands of dancers and performers from ballet, modern, contemporary and theater companies.
- She has taught for numerous dance companies, universities, and summer courses, and was movement coach to Bette Midler.
