DANCER: DeAngelo trained in the Cecchetti Method of ballet with Fredericka Mohr at Roland & Reid Dance Studios in Burbank, California. She received a Ford Foundation Scholarship to San Francisco Ballet studying with Kirov Veterans Ludmilla Shollar and Anatole Vilzak and danced with the San Francisco Opera Ballet before going the Joffrey Ballet. The New York Times said of her performance in Viva Vivaldi (photo left) *"DeAngelo is one of American ballets most spectacular dancers."* She performed in all 50 United States as well as internationally as a guest artist, including with Stars of American Ballet and Stars with World Ballet (Margot Fonteyn's last performing tour), and with partners such as Fernando Bujones.

CHOREOGRAPHER highlights: Full-evening pieces Zeitgeist I & II; The Last of the Best; and Gypsy Band. Ballet companies include: Joffrey Ballet, National Ballet of Cuba. Ohio Ballet, Pittsburgh Ballet Theater. Oregon Ballet Theater, Nevada Ballet Theater, BalletNY, ABT II, and Ballet de Monterrey. DeAngelo participated in the inaugural season of The National Choreography Initiative (2005), and was one of six chose choreographers to participate in Dance Break (2006), a high-profile showcase for choreographers in the Broadway community. She choreographed two musical in China. *The Promise* was the first original musical in China (photo right below with Chinese Acrobats) performed at the Shanghai Expo 2010. And *Dream City* (2018) based on the legendary leader Kublai Kahn. (On the Left is Jola, the lead Soprano in Beijing)

These were the first multi-genre dance extravaganzas.

Ms. DeAngelo has taught, for numerous dance companies, universities and summer courses; and continues to teach her inspirational workshops to non-dancers called "Bringing Performance to Life". She has also taught ballet, and been movement coach to Bette Midler.




